Call to Order

Mr. DiPietro called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

New Business

Mr. DiPietro advised the Annual Report will be due soon. Sgt. Cashman will get the numbers and grant figures for that report.

Old Business

Mr. DiPietro stated there has been no update from the residents of Juniper Circle concerning the bus route and no update from McQueston Drive concerning the street lights. Mr. DiPietro asked Sgt. Cashman at the last meeting, to check on accidents reported near McQueston Drive. He reported they checked the accident reports for the last four years and found one motor vehicle accident in 2015 and none relating to street lights.

Police Report

Sgt. Cashman reported there were 217 motor vehicle stops, with nine calls for reckless motor vehicle operation, 12 accidents, and two motor vehicle arrests.

Road Agent Report

Road Agent Dross reported the Highway Department is focusing on the pending storm and trees on Hunting Road and Hooksett Road. The salt shed is full. Roads being patched are holding better with the new patch since November.
