

**Town of Auburn
Highway Safety Committee
November 20, 2019**

Committee Members Present: Mike DiPietro, Chairman, Road Agent Mike Dross, Dan Carpenter, Dennis Vieira and Officer Karl Hanson

Call to Order: Mr. DiPietro called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Police Report

Officer Hanson reported during the past month there were 227 stops, 37 summonses, seven arrests and two motor vehicle arrests.

Road Agent's Report

Road Agent Dross reported paving will be tomorrow, Friday and next week. Plow trucks are getting ready and they are watching for black ice. The cemetery stones were set at the Robie Cemetery and a big limb that came down was moved from Auburn Village Cemetery. Line striping has been done.

Road Agent Dross noted he is discussing ownership issues with the state on Hooksett Road from Old Candia to Rockingham Road.

A resident complained at the November 18th Board of Selectmen's meeting about water being drawn from the brook at intersection of Steam Mill Road and Pingree Hill Road causing safety issues and was directed to attend this meeting or send an email with suggestions. It was noted no accidents have been reported as a result of drawing water at this location.

Mr. Carpenter reported a large tree is blocking site distance on Lover's Lane. Sergeant Cashman is working with the Southern NH Planning Commission on the road audit applications for roads of concern to be considered by the NH Department of Transportation.

New Business

Mr. DiPietro reported a resident complained at the November 18th Board of Selectmen's meeting about the all way stops installed at Steam Mill and Wellesley, as stops are not designed to reduce speed.

Review October 19, 2019 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Dross motioned to approve the October 19, 2019 minutes. Mr. Vieira seconded the motion. Mr. Vieira and Officer Hanson abstained due to absence from that meeting. The vote was three in favor and two abstained, the motion was approved.
