The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) has made its selection of projects, which will utilize Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds. Selections were based on recommendations submitted by the Transportation Alternatives Program Scoring Committee, as well as staff consideration of budget constraints (4 funding categories by population) as required by FHWA, and equity to top regional priorities and underserved communities.

We regret to inform you that your application 16-01TAP (Construct Multi-use path on west side of Hooksett Road and Chester Road (NH Rte. 121)) was not selected for funding. There were 12 projects funded out of 46 total applications. Your application ranked 18 out of the total. The Department has approved your project and moved it onto a reserve list of projects that are unfunded. If over the next two fiscal years additional Transportation Alternatives Program funding becomes available projects on this reserve list will be considered for funding based on their ranking, funding needs and population region. If no additional funding becomes available for your project, you will have to reapply when the next round of TAP begins.


