

PARKING DURING A SNOWSTORM March, 1972

- A. From November 1 to April 1 of each year no person shall park any motor vehicle on any public highway between the hours of 11 P.M. and 8 A.M. or at any other time in such a manner as to impede snow removal operations.
- B. Any vehicle parked in violation of section A hereof may be towed by the road agent, the chief of police or their agents or by independent contractors engaged by the road agent or the chief of police; any vehicles so towed shall be stored and released to the owner only upon payment of the cost of towing and storage by the owner as established from time to time by the board of selectmen.
- C. Any person violating section A hereof shall be subject to a penalty not to exceed twenty-five dollars for each offense.
