Item#4, Facilities update. The old fire station is on the market. The rehab of the soccer field at Wayne Eddows seems to be going well. There is an issue with the irrigation and the volume of water required to run it efficiently and effectively. Dialog will be ongoing to find a solution. Both Soccer and Little League had good and successful seasons and Wayne Eddows had a lot of usage despite the soccer field being closed. The light is replaced at Circle of Fun. The new one should be good for up to 10 years and uses significantly less electricity, saving the town on electricity. Thanks to Glen Shaw and Auburn Electric for the installation. The Parks are being policed daily for needles and a procedure in place in conjunction with the Fire Dept. for their safe removal in the event we find any. Some repairs were necessary to the play structure at COF playground. Mike Dobmeier is dealing with the Manufacturer for possible warrantee of the parts needing repair. We have only found a few Bee nests so far this year. Hopefully this trend continues given then bee problems of the past 2 years. We replaced 5 flag holders and remounted the flags along Chester Rd. We have a significant amount of work to do regarding the leveling and painting of the Gazebo, brush and tree removal at Wayne Eddows, Veterans Park and COF. Dave Nye is going to speak to the City of Manchester to have them remove the tree at Veterans Park, Rock relocation from the Town Hall to Veterans Park, painting and repairs to Appletree Park playground, picnic table repairs and general park maintenance. Proper Identification will be worn by Parks and Recreation employees when in any park during open hours. Jim Headd informed us that Armand does not possess a computer so he does not receive emails. Dave Nye will communicate with him through the town hall going forward.

Item#5, A pickup truck for the Parks and Rec. Dept. Mike Dobmeier is going to research the possibility of acquiring a used vehicle from the state.
