AUBURN POLICE COMMISSION NON-PUBLIC SESSION MINUTES
June 29, 2018

Present: David Dion, Police Commissioner, Dennis McCarthy, Police Commissioner, Michael Rolfe, Police Commissioner, Chief Edward Picard, Lt. Ray Pelton, Lillian Deeb, Office Manager and Karl Hanson.

D. McCarthy - motioned to go into non-public pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II (b), the hiring of any person as a public employee at 8:05 am. **M. Rolfe** – second. **D. Dion** – polled the members having received the affirmative for all.

Chief – comments the background investigation has been completed and approved and here for the commissioners to have opportunity to ask questions of candidate. **D. McCarthy** – questions whether the camera is off. **R. Pelton** – affirms and comments the background went well and Karl will be coming to the department with 10 years of experience. **K. Hanson** – clarifies 11 years. **R. Pelton** – mentions background went well and comments good recommendations from Pembroke Chief. He further explains reason why looking to get the appointment done sooner. He mentions department would like time allowed for notice to Pembroke because Auburn has good relationship and not looking to disrupt Pembroke. He further comments with Karl's number of years of service, looking to hire at labor grade 7, step 11. **D. Dion** – asks approximate start date considered. **R. Pelton** – explains the department was hoping as early as July 16th or 23th depending on Pembroke and notice. **D. Dion** – asks about the planned FTO training. **R. Pelton** – explains the plan if for July and August, then add on schedule in September alone as second officer. Further explains the officer bid on shifts and come October they begin a new rotation. **D. McCarthy** – asks why Karl is leaving Pembroke and why he want to come to Auburn. **K. Hanson** – explains Pembroke is a good department and doesn't necessarily want to leave there, commenting made a lot of friends, some good people there and been there for 10 years, however looking for progressive career change. He explains his daughter is member of the Auburn volunteer fire and rescue department and relayed good things about the Auburn Police Department and mentioned the opening. He goes on to explain he reached out to Detective Chabot who recommended forwarding resume. **Chief** – mentions Karl only lives about 5 minutes away. **D. McCarthy** – questions if Karl lives nearby? **K. Hanson** – comments lives off traffic circle. **M. Rolfe** – questions, Manchester? **K. Hanson** – affirms. **D. McCarthy** – comments on having 10 or 11 years in NH retirement and Mr. Hanson has another 9 or 10 years. **K. Hanson** – clarifies his years of service and service years with the NH Lottery Commission. **D. McCarthy** -comments looking for good fit in with excellent team they have here and fit with these great guys. He further mentions many past officers have come from other surrounding agencies and not for monetary but for lifestyle. **D. Dion** – clarifies the commissioner will come out of non-public to make motion to hire.
