Third: Are you in favor of approving the cost items for year two of a two-year collective bargaining agreement which resulted from negotiations between the Auburn Board of Selectmen and the Auburn Police Commission and the Auburn Police Union, Local 216 and which represents an estimated increase of \$8,810 over FY 2014 salaries, fringe benefits and other cost items at the current staffing level for the ensuing year; and further to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight thousand eight hundred ten dollars (\$8,810), such sum representing the negotiated increase over 2014 salaries, fringe benefits and other cost items at the current staffing levels.
