## Auburn Residents Only

### Recycling Materials: **Commingled Containers**

**Glass:** Clear, brown, green, blue glass  
Food and beverage containers

**Plastic:** PET #1, Soft drink and liquor bottles  
Milk, water, juice containers, laundry, bleach  
Cleaning containers

**Metal Cans:** Aluminum cans (soft drink, juice, beverage cans)  
Steel (tin & soup cans)  
Aluminum pie tins & foil

**Non-Acceptable Materials:**  
5-gallon pails, plastic utensils, plastic bags, ceramics  
Lids and caps. Window glass, mirrors, heat resistant oven wear  
Light bulbs, drinking glasses. Empty paint, gas cans or any container that previously contained hazardous, toxic materials.

### Recycling Paper: **Commingled Paper**

**Paper:** Newspaper, Phonebooks, Greeting cards, Paperback books, Brochures, Folders, Magazines.  
Flyers, Old Mail, Catalogues. Clean food boxes (liners removed), Paper towel rolls, Shoe boxes, any clean paperboard product.

**Non-Acceptable Materials:**  
Waxed Paper, Used tissue, Soiled paper, Plastic bags.

**OVER**

**Corrugated Cardboard** – No Styrofoam or Plastic and No Wax Coated Cardboard

**Tires:** Car tires accepted off rims.

**Scrap Metals:** Washers & Dryers, bikes, stoves, Gas grills, and any loose metals.

Note: Propane tanks need to be empty and are placed in separate area. Any gas operated machine needs to be empty of all gas and oil.

**Appliances Containing CFCs (Freon):** Refrigerators, Freezers, Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, and water coolers are placed in a separate container next to Transfer Station Building.

**Note:** Branches, old logs, no larger than 3” in diameter and no longer than 3’.

**Note:** OIL & Vehicle Batteries are collected at the Old Town Facility the first Saturday of the month from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm. NO Hazardous Wastes.

You may also bring used oil to Babb Motors, 20 Commercial St. Monday – Friday  
8:00 am – 5:00 pm

**\*NO Anti-Freeze or Batteries\***

Anti-freeze and Household Hazardous Waste will be collected at the Household Hazardous Waste Day. Contact the Selectmen’s office for next date.

The Transfer Station does **not** accept liquids or any Hazardous Wastes.
