Fifth: Are you in favor of raising and appropriating the sum of One hundred-eighty-seven thousand eight hundred sixty dollars (\$187,860) for road and drainage system improvements at the intersection of Wilson Crossing Road and Hunting Road, on a portion of Rockingham Road, and Hook Road; and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept and expend for this purpose grants of federal or state aid, or both, as may be available, including, but not limited to, \$140,895 to be received through Hazard Mitigation Program Grants from the State of New Hampshire and FEMA, with the balance of \$46,965 to be raised by taxes. And further to authorize the Board of Selectmen to do all things necessary to carry out the purposes of this appropriation. (Recommended by the Board of Selectmen) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)

Sixth: Are you in favor of raising and appropriating the sum of One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to continue wastewater planning efforts begun in 2008 by developing an Inter-Municipal Agreement to provide wastewater service and to design and permit the connection between Dartmouth Drive / Wellington Business Park and the City of Manchester system on By-Pass 28; and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept and expend for this purpose grants of federal or state aid, or both, as may be available, including, but not limited to, \$10,000 to come from a Community Technical Assistance Program grant from the NH Department of Transportation; \$20,000 to come from a State Matching Grant through the NH Department of Environmental Services, \$10,000 to come from an Economic Development Grant to come from the Rockingham Economic Development Corporation, and furthermore to authorize the use of \$60,000 from the unreserved fund balance (surplus) as of December 31, 2008. (Recommended by the Board of Selectmen) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)

Second: Are you in favor of raising and appropriating an operating budget, not including appropriations special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the Warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purpose set forth therein, totaling ten million, seven hundred forty-four thousand, five hundred fourteen dollars and seventy-four cents (\$10,744,514.74)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be ten million, eight hundred seventy-six thousand, seven hundred sixty-two dollars (\$10,876,762), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Auburn School District, or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (This article does not include appropriations in any other warrant articles.)
