Call to Order

Mr. DiPietro called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

New Business

Mr. DiPietro reminded Eva Komaridis' name should be removed from the notification list.

Mr. Eaton advised t a resident from McQueston Drive had come to the Selectmen's meeting to ask about getting a street light and was going to contact Eversource to see if he could pay for it himself, if supported by the Selectmen. The Selectmen were not in favor of a light. Mr. DiPietro reported the resident had been asked to come to the Highway Safety meeting but has not contacted anyone. Sgt. Cashman advised the area in question has clear visibility from end to end. It never hurts to have a light. Drivers cut through Sandy Knoll Drive. Mr. DiPietro asked Sgt. Cashman to check on accidents reported near McQueston Drive. Sgt. Cashman advised the problem is speeding and lights won't help with that, but he will check the accident reports.

Old Business

Mr. DiPietro stated there has been no update from the residents of Juniper Circle concerning the bus route.

Police Report

Officer Cashman reported there were 213 motor vehicle stops, with 23 summons issued, 11 accidents, and seven arrests. There were seven calls for reckless operation, two motor vehicle complaints. There was an incident with sudden road freezing with a delayed response from DOT of an hour. Mr. Eaton recommended if that continues to send a letter to the district.
