

**Town of Auburn
Highway Safety Committee
December 18, 2019
(Amended January 15, 2020)**

Committee Members Present: Mike DiPietro, Chairman, Dan Carpenter, Dennis Vieira and Sergeant Cashman

Call to Order: Mr. DiPietro called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM.

Old Business

Mr. DiPietro reviewed the complaint raised with the Board of Selectmen by a resident on Pingree Hill Road about safety issues and noise with water being drawn from the brook at the intersection of Steam Mill Road and Pingree Hill Road. The withdrawal of water is not within the purview of the Highway Safety Committee and there is no ordinance against it, but Mr. DiPietro questioned whether there had been any accidents reported. Sergeant Cashman indicated there had not been any accidents or complaints filed with the Police Department.

Sergeant Cashman reviewed the status of the three applications for NHDOT Road Safety Audits he had sent into the Southern NH Planning Commission as a result of the meeting with them. The criteria were not met as to deaths or incapacitations within the last 10 years, but he will save the information if they come back.

Mr. DiPietro noted the intersection of Hooksett and Depot Roads has not been relocated. It is part of overall negotiations with Manchester Water Works, Auburn School District and the Board of Selectmen on several items. They will be discussing several things. The surveying has been done, but a land swap would need to occur in order to accomplish the project.

Police Report

Sergeant Cashman reported 178 stops, 21 summonses, four arrests and four motor vehicle accidents. Sergeant Cashman advised that Manchester Road had been closed for 24 hours Sunday to Monday as water had gone over the road.

Review November 20, 2019 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Vieira motioned to approve the November 20, 2019 minutes. Mr. Carpenter seconded the motion. Sergeant Cashman abstained due to absence from that meeting. Approved 3-0-1.
