Call to Order: Chair DiPietro called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Police Report

Sgt. Cashman reported 135 motor vehicle stops, eight (8) summonses, 17 arrests (12 from motor vehicle stops and eight DWI), and 21 motor vehicle crashes. Sgt. Cashman noted an increase in DWI over last month and road conditions from storms. He said the town roads were good during the storm, but he was concerned with the response from the State. Londonderry Turnpike had 100 cars off the road and was temporarily shut down.

Road Agent Report

Road Agent Dross reported water issues, some frozen ditches and icy spots. A few pot holes will need patching when it warms up and trees are being monitored. He hopes to get the crane for a day for tree work. The Auburn Village School pick up and drop off volume continues to be monitored as traffic is backing up onto adjacent roadways and emergency vehicles may have difficulty.

Mr. Carpenter motioned to approve the December 15, 2021 meeting minutes seconded by Mr. Dross. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.
