- Second:** Are you in favor of approving the cost items related to the first year of a five-year collective bargaining agreement which resulted from negotiations between the Auburn Board of Selectmen, the Auburn Police Commission and the Auburn Police Union, Local 216 and which represents an estimated increase of \$53,022 over FY 2021 salaries, fringe benefits and other cost items at the current staffing level for the ensuing year; and further to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty-three thousand, twenty-two dollars (\$53,022), to fund those cost items for FY 2022. Cost items for FY 2023, FY 2024, FY 2025 and FY 2026 will be presented to the voters for their approval in March 2023, March 2024, March 2025 and March 2026 in accordance with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement. (Majority vote required) **(Recommended by the Board of Selectmen) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

- Third:** Are you in favor of raising and appropriating the sum of Twenty-five-thousand dollars (\$25,000) to be placed into the Fleet Maintenance and Replacement Expendable Trust Fund previously established. The sum of \$25,000 to come from the unreserved fund balance (surplus) as of December 31, 2021 with no additional amount to come from taxation in 2022. (Majority vote required) **(Recommended by the Board of Selectmen) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

- Fourth:** Are you in favor of raising and appropriating the sum of Twenty-five-thousand dollars (\$25,000) to be placed into the Accrued Benefits Liability Expendable Trust Fund previously established. The sum of \$25,000 to come from the unreserved fund balance (surplus) as of December 31, 2021 with no additional amount to come from taxation in 2022. (Majority vote required) **(Recommended by the Board of Selectmen) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**
